Q: How old does a child need to be to ride the equipment?

A: There is no age minimum. As long as they are comfortable riding on the lap of an equipment operator, they can ride.

Q: Can parents/guardians ride with or next to the child on the equipment?

A: No, only children 17 and under are permitted on the equipment with a licensed operator.

Q: What if my child does not want to ride equipment, but would like to explore the event?

A: You can purchase the \$20 static display ticket.

Q: What shoes should we wear to this event?

A: Closed-toed shoes are required for all attendees.
