

AACCNJ Training Program



Recently, the Labor Department partnered with the African American Chamber of Commerce of New Jersey (AACCNJ), the New Jersey Community Colleges Consortium (NJCCC), and Workforce Solutions of America (WSA) to provide basic skills training for employees of businesses throughout the state that are members of AACCNJ. The training will be provided at no charge to AACCNJ's members. However, employees taking the classes must be paid at their regular hourly rate while in training.

AACCNJ's members can receive training on-site at their company location or at any of the 63 community college campus locations across the state.

- Computer Applications (Windows, Excel, Outlook, Word, & Internet)
- Communications (verbal & written)
- Mathematics & Measurement
