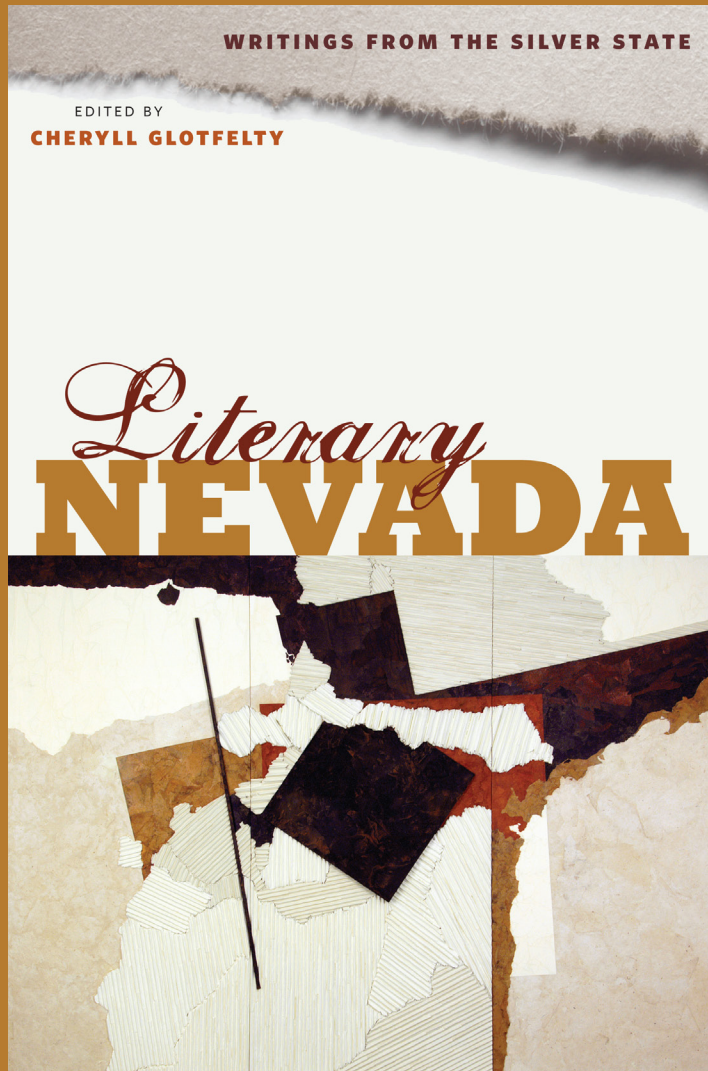


Nevada Stories: Something to Talk About!
