agreement. In the case of a minor, a parent or guardian must sign. A list of all participants, with their name and signature, can be attached to this appli-

cation. The agreement must be returned with the parade entry forms.

By signing this agreement, I accept responsibility to ensure that all parties participating in the parade are provided the rules and regulations to

participate in the parade and that the onsite parade entry coordinator has a copy with them on the day of the parade.
