citizen OF THE YEAR – An outstanding individual who lives or works in Branch County recognized for their impact on the lives and citizens of this community. This special individual shows dedication and spirit beyond what is considered regular duty. Nominee must have demonstrated integrity and ethics and have made a significant contribution to our community over the course of their career.

teacher or administrator who has demonstrated a superior capacity to inspire a love of learning in students. This individual should be a role model and inspiration to the education community and demonstrate leadership by their participation in community events and organizations.

BUSINESS OF THE YEAR – A business, small or large, that goes out of its way to become a community partner. This business donates time, resources and leadership to support projects and activities that benefit the community. This business exemplifies commitment to growth within the community.

OUTSTANDING PUBLIC SERVICE or

The category public service includes, but is not limited to, leaders in health care, police, fire, housing & development initiatives, city/county employees and/or elected officials.
