**BANK FISHING** – MIGHT TRY FISHING THE JETTIES IN PRATTVILLE WITH SW10 KASTMASTER OR NIGHT CRAWLERS WITH POWER BAIT—CRICKETS WITH MEAL WORMS DOWN BY THE DAM FOR TROUT—MAYBE TRY A TASMANIAN DEVIL—IT MIGHT DO THE TRICK. HEARING SOME GOOD REPORTS AT HAMILTON BRANCH-SALMON ROE.

**BOAT FISHING** – EARLY MORNING IS THE BEST TIME FOR TROLLERS FOR RAINBOWS AND BROWNS. SOME ARE TAKING FISH WITH RED/GOLD SPEEDY SHINERS OR AN UNCLE LARRY'S ORANGE FIRE TIGER WITH CARP SPIT OR KRILL SCENT ON THE RED BANK DOWN 20 TO 30 FEET. SALMON 2-4

LBS BEING CAUGHT BY THE DAM AND THE BIG SPRINGS AREA WITH ANCHOVY TAILS ON SIZE #1 OR #2 OCTOPUS HOOK A COUPLE CRANKS OFF THE BOTTOM. THE HOT TICKET ESPECIALLY FOR KIDS ARE SMALLMOUTH BASS WITH CRICKETS ON #10 BAITHOLDER HOOK AND BB OR 3/0 SPLIT SHOT 12" FROM THE HOOK ALL AROUND THE LAKE AT THE POINTS & DROP OFFS— ALSO WITH RUBBER WORMS SUCH AS BRUSH HOGS
