BANK FISHING – TRY FISHING THE JETTIES IN PRATTVILLE & THE USUAL HAMILTON BRANCH WITH SW10 KASTMASTERS OR NIGHT CRAWLERS AND POWER BAIT. CRICKETS ARE WORKING ALSO. BROWNS & RAINBOWS OF DECENT SIZE. THE DAM MIGHT BE A GOOD SPOT.

BOAT FISHING – GOOD REPORTS FROM-TROLLERS TAKING FISH WITH RED/GOLD SPEEDY SHINERS AND VARIOUS RAPALAS— ADD CARP SPIT OR TROPHY TROUT GO DOWN 10 TO 20 FEET ALONG THE EAST OR WEST SHORES FOR GOOD SIZE BROWNS AND RAINBOWS. TRY BIG SPRING AND BY THE DAM FOR SALMON WITH ANCHOVY

TAILS WITH SIZE #1 OR #2 OCTOPUS HOOK A FEW CRANKS OFF THE BOTTOM. THE SMALLMOUTH SHOULD START PICKING UP AS THE WEATHER IMPROVES AT THE POINTS & DROPOFFS ALL AROUND THE LAKE WITH VARIOUS RUBBER WORMS MAYBE A BRUSH HOG. ALSO CRICKETS ON A SIZE 10 BAITHOLDER AND A BB OR 3/0 SPLIT SHOT 12” FROM YOUR HOOK

PLANTS: Clear Creek, Goodrich, Eagle Lake, Lower Susan River. Almanor last week

EAGLE LAKE– Opens Saturday —Try Eagle’s Nest or Youth Camp with a bobber & night crawler—Launching can be tricky. Have to wait & see
