BANK FISHING – TRY FISHING THE JETTIES IN PRATTVILLE & THE USUAL HAMILTON BRANCH WITH SW10 KASTMASTERS OR NIGHT CRAWLERS AND POWER BAIT. CRICKETS ARE WORKING ALSO. BROWNS & RAINBOWS OF DECENT SIZE. THE DAM MIGHT BE A GOOD SPOT.

BOAT FISHING – GOOD REPORTS FROM-TROLLERS TAKING FISH WITH RED/GOLD SPEEDY SHINERS AND VARIOUS RAPALAS— ADD CARP SPIT OR TROPHY TROUT GO DOWN 10 TO 30 FEET ALONG THE EAST OR WEST SHORES FOR GOOD SIZE BROWNS AND RAINBOWS. HEARD MANY EXCELLENT REPORTS BY THE DAM FOR SALMON

WITH ANCHOVY TAILS (SARDINES) WITH SIZE #1 OR #2 OCTOPUS HOOK A FEW CRANKS OFF THE BOTTOM. SMALLMOUTH IS PICKING UP AS THE WEATHER IMPROVES AT THE POINTS & DROPOFFS ALL AROUND THE LAKE WITH VARIOUS RUBBER WORMS MAYBE A BRUSH HOG. CRICKETS ON A SZ 10 BAITHOLDER WITH 3/0 SPLIT SHOT 12” FROM YOUR HOOK
