Speaker: Jeanene Smith, M.D., MPH

The Chamber Coalition's Government Affairs Committee welcomes Jeanene Smith, M.D., MPH, Administrator of the Office for Oregon Health Policy and Research. This office advises the Legislature and Governor on health policy. Dr. Smith has an extensive background in health care and insurance coverage. Her work has focused primarily on Medicaid benefit design, cost-sharing strategies and quality of care in new emerging models.

Dr. Smith is a graduate of Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU) School of Medicine. She spent eight years in private practice in Portland, where she served five years as her clinic's Medical Director. She has co-authored several health services research journal articles and made numerous presentations to national forums related to the Oregon Health Plan changes. She is also now serving as a state representative on both the Oregon's Public Employees Benefit Board and the Oregon Healthcare Quality Corporation. She will speak earlier in the day to Leadership Corvallis in a presentation titled *Access, Quality and Cost: The Promise and Perils of Health Care Reform*.
