Judged Entries

- Entries may arrive at the assembly area as early as 4pm.
- **NO JUDGING will occur in the line-up areas in the Woodland Elementary School & Lincoln Middle School parking lots. Entries WILL be judged from the grandstand in front of Mojo's Music.**
- **It is important that your line-up number, which you will receive in your parade packet from the Ed/Glen Chamber approximately one week prior to the parade, be prominently displayed in the passenger side of your vehicle. This will allow judges to quickly identify judged entries during the parade.**
- Professional (leased or rented) floats are not eligible for judging.
- Decision of the judges is final.
- Awards will be given in the following categories:
 - Large Commercial (15 + full time employees)
 - 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place plaques
 - Small Commercial (fewer than 15 full time employees)
 - 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place plaques
 - Large Non-Profit (more than 100 members)
 - 1st Place \$100; 2nd Place \$75; 3rd Place \$50
 - Small Non-Profit (less than 100 members)
 - 1st Place \$100; 2nd Place \$75; 3rd Place \$50
 - Neighborhood, School, & Youth Groups
 - 1st Place \$100; 2nd Place \$75; 3rd Place \$50
- The GRAND PRIZE winner will be chosen from the best of the five 1st place winners and will be awarded the 'Grand Prize Plaque'
- **Judging criteria include:**

CLARITY OF THEME PORTRAYED: *(Maximum 5 Points Awarded)*

Oh, The Places You'll Go!

How well the float design concept adapts to the parade theme.

WORKMANSHIP: *(Maximum 5 Points Awarded)*

The craftsmanship in the float creation. Detail, design, use of colors & materials.

ORIGINALITY: *(Maximum 5 Points Awarded)*

Creativeness & originality in float, concept, uniqueness, creative use of materials.

PIZZAZZ: *(Maximum 5 Points Awarded)*

Extra points will be awarded to entries with lights, special effects, or sound effects.
