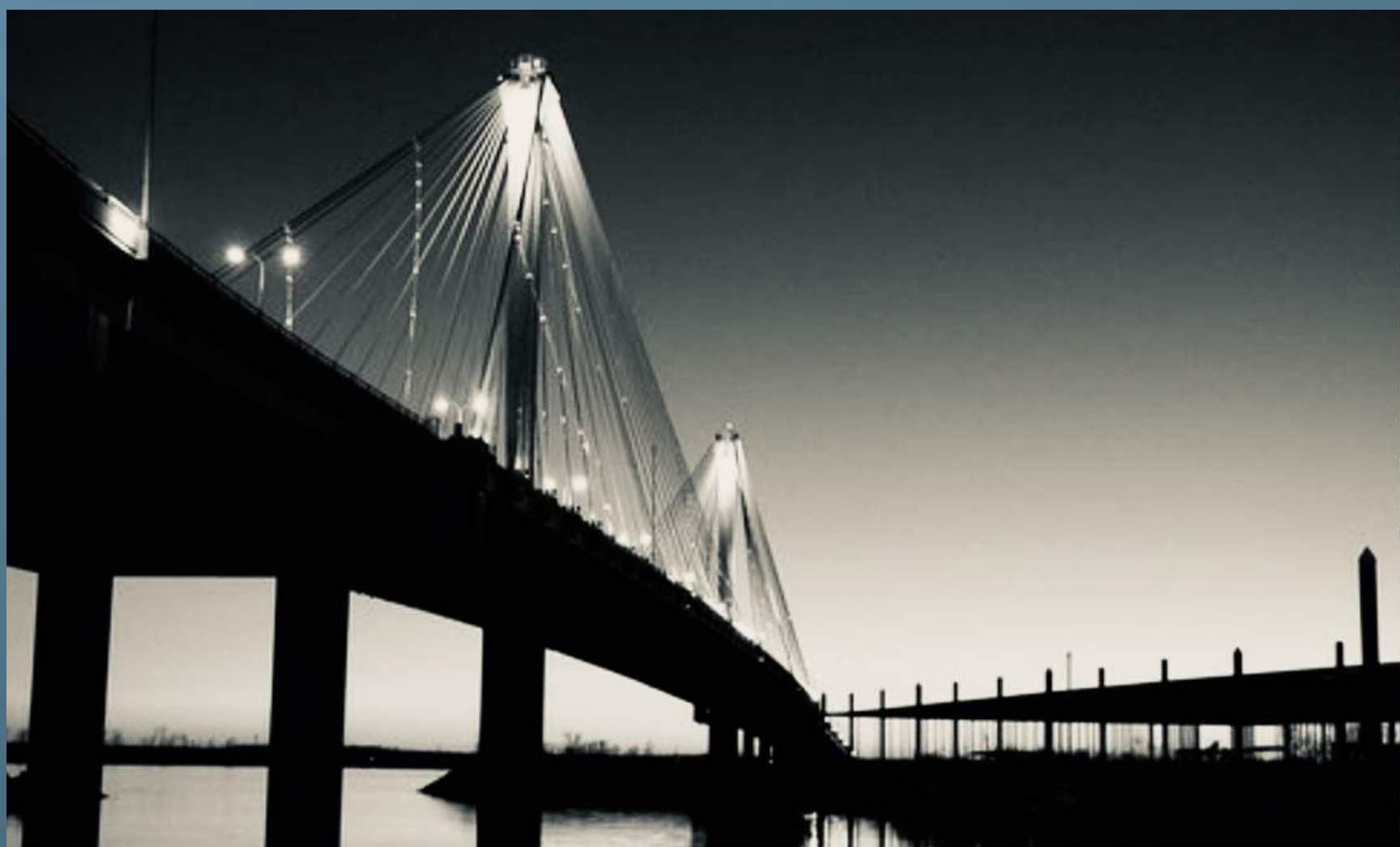

**Responsibilities** — Upon “written complaint that any property is over assessed or under assessed” to “review the assessment, and correct it, as appears to be just.”

Review assessments on its own motion

Review assessment corrections Equalize assessments between townships

Make a final determination regarding homestead exemptions.

Make recommendations to the Illinois Department of Revenue regarding non- homestead exemptions.

Represent the interest of Madison County before the Illinois Property Tax Appeal Board.

**Responsibilities** — The officer presides over the adjudication of violations of county ordinances regulating the abatement of public nuisances; the accumulation, disposal, and transportation of garbage and refuse; the construction and maintenance of buildings and structures; sanitation practices; and zoning, to the extent permitted by the Illinois constitution. This program has been highly effective for obtaining more timely compliance and reducing the caseload for the State’s Attorney’s Office and the courts at a low cost.

**Responsibilities** — Duties of the ETSB include planning a 9-1-1 system; oordinating and supervising the implementation and maintenance of the system, including the establishment of equipment specifications and coding systems; receiving moneys for deposit into the ETSB fund; authorizing disbursements from the fund; hiring any staff necessary for the implementation and upgrade of the system.

The Health Advisory Committee ensures that all state laws and county ordinances regarding the preservation of health are upheld through observation and enforcement. To this end, the Board of Health authorizes and executes any necessary health inspections and investigations in the county.

The Health Advisory Committee is chaired by the Executive Director for the Health Department.

The Health Advisory Committee provide expert knowledge and advice to the Board of Health and the Health Department regarding public health policies and issues along with advice on strategic initiatives related to public health.

# FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICTS

**Responsibilities** — Provides a variety of services that protect the lives and property of District residents from the adverse effects of fires, sudden medical emergencies, or exposures to dangerous conditions. The Districts provide Fire Suppression & Rescue, Advanced Life Support Ambulance service, and Fire Protection services. It also conducts fire service training for local fire departments, monthly CPR courses for the public, and numerous public education programs by request.

**Term** — 3 years

**Compensation** — \$1,000 to \$2,000 per year depending on size of district.

**Composition** — 3 to 5 members appointed by the county board chair with approval of the County Board.
