The air is tinged with excitement as the planning committee for the Ruby Mountain Film Festival puts in place the final preparations for the inaugural event scheduled for August 11-14. While reflecting on the Elko area's long history with and special ties to Hollywood and the film industry, the idea of the Ruby Mountain Film Festival was born. Led by Kurt Stefka, who brings an extensive career both in front of and behind the camera, and film festival expert Jon Fitzgerald, the festival will present a full range of storytelling through visual arts from independent and student filmmakers to full-feature Hollywood movies, documentaries, and the Western genre, with a particular emphasis on student filmmaking. "Everything is really coming together and we are looking forward to bringing this great event to Elko," said Stefka, the events chairman and founder. "The response from the film industry has been fantastic. We initially received over 260 films submitted from over 40 countries around the world vying for a spot in the festival lineup. The final lineup will exhibit over 60 films, representing directors and producers from over 18 countries. The festival will truly be an international event." Festivities will kick-off on Thursday evening, August 11th with the Opening Night Gala. The gala will include a reception, art auction, "Taste of Elko" presentation and the premiere screening. Friday and Saturday will offer the opportunity to view films from many different genres and categories, starting in the morning each day and running well into the evening. Screenings will be presented at the Convention Center, GBC Theater and the Red Lion. The festival will wrap up on Sunday with a full day of screenings followed by the Awards Ceremony. Due to the fantastic response we have received from the industry, we will be presenting multiple forms of filmmaking. We have added a "Family Block", "Local Filmmaker Block" and "Experimental Block" to the originally planned schedule. There are multiple offerings in the feature film, documentary, animation, short film and student film categories. We have also created a "World Cinema" sub-category for most of the film varieties being presented."
