



## Preserving the Past, Inspiring the Future: Northeastern Nevada Museum

This month, the Elko Area Chamber is proud to spotlight the Northeastern Nevada Museum (NNM), a cornerstone of cultural preservation and education in our region. A Chamber member since 2000, the Museum has been serving the Elko community for an impressive 57 years, sharing the stories, artifacts, and heritage that shape northeastern Nevada.

### Preserving the Past, Inspiring the Future

At the heart of the Northeastern Nevada Museum is a deep commitment to preserving local history and sparking curiosity among visitors. According to Executive Director Lauren Roovaart, the Museum is motivated by a desire to share the rich and diverse stories of the past—from Native American history and railroad heritage to mining, geology, wildlife, and Great Basin art. The goal is not only education, but inspiration, with hopes that each patron leaves having learned something new or discovered a newfound passion.

### A Valued Chamber Partnership

The Museum credits the Elko Area Chamber with helping expand its reach within the community. Through Chamber support and promotion, the Northeastern Nevada Museum is able to keep residents and visitors informed about exhibits, programs, and events—ultimately welcoming new patrons through its doors and strengthening community engagement.

### An Interesting Piece of History

One unique fact that highlights the Museum's grassroots beginnings is that the Northeastern Nevada Historical Society, which established the Museum, was founded by local families determined to preserve the region's history. Before the Museum building was even completed, these families began collecting and storing historical objects in the old basement—laying the foundation for what would become a treasured community institution.






