F.I.S.H.: Meeting Needs & Changing Lives

This month, the Elko Area Chamber is proud to highlight Friends In Service Helping—better known throughout the community as F.I.S.H. Serving the region for an impressive 38 years and a Chamber member since 1990, F.I.S.H. continues to make a profound difference in the lives of individuals and families in need.

A Mission of Hope & Life-Changing Support

Guided by the motto “Meeting needs and changing lives,” F.I.S.H. focuses on providing essential resources and compassionate care. Executive Director Tim Royal, who began leading the organization in August 2025, shared that his greatest motivation comes from seeing people regain stability and wholeness thanks to the assistance and hope offered through F.I.S.H.’s programs.

While many recognize the organization through its well-known thrift store, F.I.S.H. is so much more than retail. The organization distributes 15–30 tons of food each month through its food bank, provides over 200 hot meals per week through its soup kitchen, and operates a 21-bed homeless shelter—the only one within the large region spanning Reno to Salt Lake and Boise to Las Vegas. Additionally, the F.I.S.H. team offers case management services to connect individuals and families with the resources needed to rebuild their lives.

A Strong Chamber Partnership

F.I.S.H. values its longstanding relationship with the Elko Area Chamber. Royal expressed appreciation for the ongoing support: “The Chamber is an amazing asset through help with social media, networking, graphic design, and feedback. Literally sitting with us and asking how they can help while constantly being a sounding board for our ideas.”

This collaboration helps strengthen outreach efforts and ensures that those who need support know where to find it.
