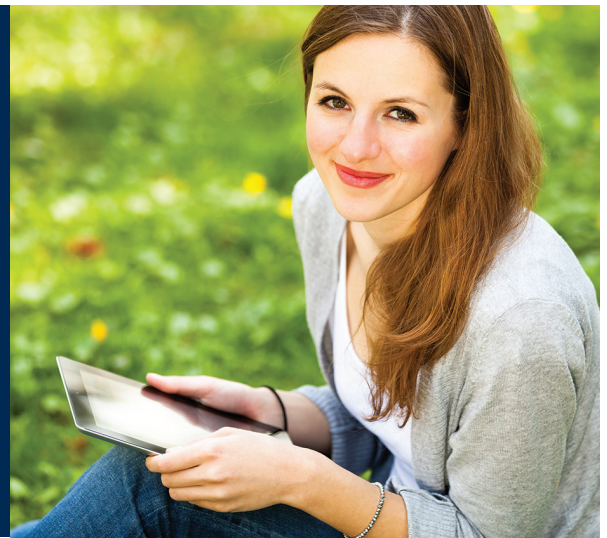


MASTER OF ARTS in Organizational Leadership



Earn your master's degree in as few as 1½ years and learn to effectively lead people in an ever-changing work environment. The program is designed to prepare professionals for a range of leadership positions as it augments learners' abilities for critical and strategic decision making, personal development of leadership strengths, and more effective engagement in the art and science of leadership practices among diverse individuals.

The program through analytical inquiry offers key distinguished features including:

- **Systems thinking.** Determines how decisions impact entire organizations. Become a more effective leader with an integrative approach to decision making.
- **Ethical leadership.** Creates logical leaders with ethical mindsets by focusing less on traditional views of leadership and more on the nature of ethical inquiry.
- **Leading change.** Understanding the sociology of leadership helps bring passion to leadership, turn the tide of nonsense, and look at roles as influence-makers.
