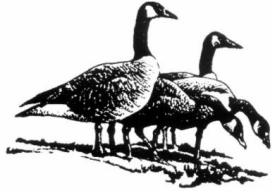

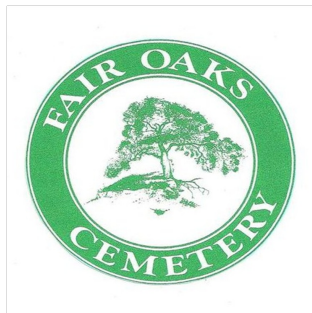

Joshua Gumacal a junior at Del Campo is currently our Jr. Honorary Mayor and is on our Fair Oaks Youth Community Board.

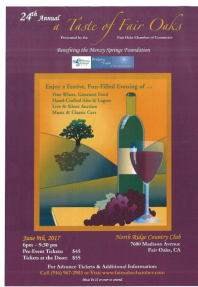
