Description

The camp is for boys and girls entering first grade to those entering sixth grade. This camp will help introduce players to basic soccer skills, such as footwork, dribbling, passing, and shooting form. In addition, players will learn about sportsmanship and especially about God's love for them through a short devotion each day.

Coaching Staff

Several coaches and volunteers will be assisting with the camp. Our staff is made up of college students, teachers, and other volunteers with various levels of soccer skills and training. Registration and Camp Fee

If your child is registered by May 31st the cost for the camp will be \$15. Beginning June 1st, the cost will be \$20. The cost for the camp must be paid to consider your child registered.

Included in the cost of registration is the camp, a Path to Victory T-Shirt, and a water bottle. Camp will be limited to 60 athletes.

The first 20 campers to sign-up in each age group (1st -2nd grade, 3rd-4th grade, 5th-6th grade) will be admitted.
