Todd Sklamberg is the Chief Executive Officer of Sunrise Hospital and Medical Center, Nevada's largest acute care facility at 762 beds, and Sunrise Children's Hospital located on the same campus. Prior to becoming CEO, Sklamberg served as the Chief Operating Officer of Sunrise Children's Hospital - Nevada's largest, most comprehensive children's hospital. Prior to joining HCA, Sklamberg served as vice president at St. Louis Children's Hospital.
