**Community Garden Schedule**

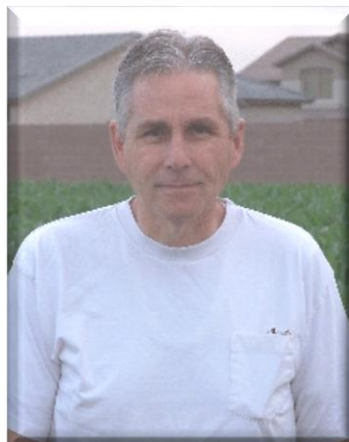
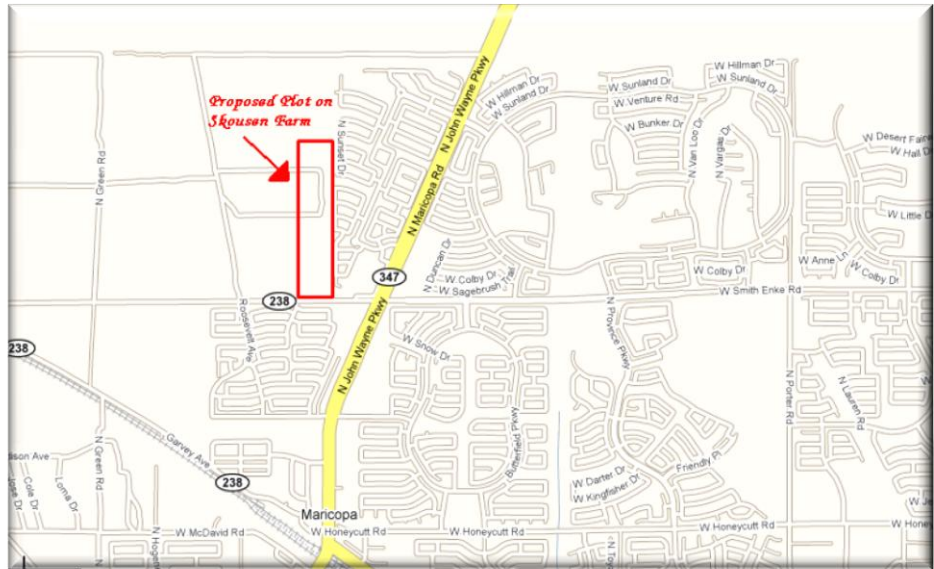

3. Only vegetables approved by the Skousen's can be planted.
4. No chemical sprays or soil additives allowed.
5. No plants or produce can be sold from the plot. ALL will be donated to F.O.R., Maricopa's local food bank (over 6,100 lbs donated in 2009).
