EVANSVILLE, Ind. — The Southern Illinois Miners used four homers and five late runs to beat the Evansville Otters 10-4 on Saturday night, clinching their third straight division title and earning a berth in the upcoming Frontier League playoffs.

It is the second time in franchise history that a team has won three straight division crowns (after the 2009 or Washington Wild Thangs and the 2010 season) to earn the Miners will be the top-seeded team.
