

Riverview Park to Host Farmers Market Saturdays Beginning Oct. 7

Melbourne, Fla., Sept. 29, 2017 — The Downtown Melbourne Farmers Market will move to Riverview Park on October 7.

This family-friendly event will be held every Saturday from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m.

Vendors offering fresh produce, flowers, prepared foods, local handmade crafts, and other artisan goods will be situated within Riverview Park's beautiful greenspace along the Indian River Lagoon.

Kids will enjoy the park's featured playground. Food trucks will be offering meals and snacks, and ample seating will be provided under the parks' five new shaded canopies. A new ¼-mile-loop trail has also recently been completed at the park, offering a nice stroll along the river.
