2. Second, you will be asked to select a non-profit organization for your donation. This is where you type in **Mohawk Valley Stewardship Council** as your preferred charity.

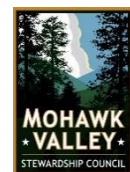
Congratulations you're done!

The ranch was acquired by the Mohawk Valley Stewardship Council (MVSC) in 2009 to preserve and restore it for the community. For more than 150 years the ranch has been famous for its warm spring waters that flow naturally from the Sierra Nevada Mountains to supply a constant flow of water for our community swimming pool.

Established in 1852, the Ranch is registered as an historic site in Plumas County, CA.
