

25 Years of Making Memories

Memory Lane started as a small nativity scene in Harry and Juanita's front yard. They soon added more figures and started hanging lights on the buildings until the U-shaped driveway was ablaze with lights. The Cow & Calf and the Bell & Arch were added in 1997.



In 1998, when they opened the Memory Lane Christmas Tree Farm, they moved all the lights to a half mile drive they built through the tree farm and added the Rocking Horse, Jack-in-the-Box and most of the Toy figures. The Rocking Horse was the highlight of the Display for 21 years. The Display grew to over 50 scenes.



In 2020, they created a new highlight when they decorated a 40' oak tree with lights and called it the Memory Tree. They added a bulletin board near the Tree and invited guests to share memories on the bulletin board. They did and by the end of the season, the 4' X 6' board was covered with memories.



Some guests say that they came to see the Lights as kids and they are now
