Bring all of your unusable items and scrap to the front parking lot of the former Technicolor Factory and, free of charge, citizens who reside within the city limits of Pinckneyville can dispose of:

- Old furniture & mattresses
- Scrap metal & Wood
- Old toys & bicycles
- Household appliances & Electronics
- TV's, VCR's, Computers, etc

- Only residents who reside within the city limits of Pinckneyville may participate.
- Identification and proof of residency will be checked on site.
- Not accepting household trash

Persons who violate these rules will be prosecuted.
