The State Division of Housing was given a grant from HUD (Housing and Urban Development) with the goal of each county in Colorado conducting a housing needs assessment. There is no cost to Park County to do the assessment, just a little foot work. The benefit will be getting valuable documentation and information that many folks can benefit from (like the Chamber of Commerce, the Planning dept., nonprofits, etc.).
