How do you feel walking up the stairs? How about getting on that bus?

Is it difficult getting into your car or truck?

This gets to be more common as one gets older. Does it have to be this way?

Absolutely not! All you need to do is do two simple exercises.

While standing, hold onto something for balance and lift one knee as high as you can, then bring it down and lift the other knee up as high as you can. Repeat up to 20 times each, once or twice a day, 4 or 5 times a week. Do not cause yourself any pain or discomfort. As you do this more often, you will find you can lift a bit higher. Lifting your knee just above your waist is as far as you would like to go.

The second exercise is to do a squat. While standing, put your feet about shoulder width apart with toes pointed slightly out. Squat down as far as you can and stand up, keeping your body upright while holding

onto something for balance. Be sure your knee follows the direction of your toes and that one or both knees do not push in towards one another. Repeat up to 20 times each, once or twice a day, 4 or 5 times a week. Do not cause yourself any pain. Going down as far as having your upper leg almost parallel to the floor is as far as you would like to go. If you can go further down without any pain or discomfort, then by all means, go for it.

These two simple exercises will help you from relying on a cane, walker, or even the wheelchair as you get more "mature". 5 to 10 minutes a day will pay off tremendously for your future years.

While walking in snow and on ice, keep your feet under you.

To your health and fitness, especially during the Holidays and Winter months.
