This is the best fly fishing near Denver that you will find. Beginners and expert fly anglers alike will enjoy fly fishing the Boxwood Gulch Area and the Long Meadow Section of the beautiful North Fork of the South Platte River. This part of the river system is both a head water and a tail water fishing experience. Located in Park County on Highway 285 just a scenic 60 minute drive Southwest of Denver.

FISHING-You will get to fish on private property with some of the best guides in the state. Tactics for each of our species varies from midging for super selective rainbows, to streamer fishing for monster browns. Boxwood Gulches population is made up of over 1500 fish on 1 mile of water with trout ranging from 12 inch brookies to 30 inch bows and browns - 50% rainbows, 30% browns, 20% cutbows, snake river cutthroats, brookies, and the elusive palomino rainbow.

HAY-Quality hay at a competitive price ... and you are supporting the following: open space, wild animals, birds of all kinds, local family ranching, clean air and water, and everything good about living in this area.

CATTLE/BEEF-We sell the Highland steers by the 1/2 carcass or 1/4 carcass. The animals are delivered to a USDA inspected packing plant, cut to your specifications and then you can pick up your beef at our ranch or we can ship it to you via Fed Ex.

Train Fast...Be Fast

Now that we have an idea of the concept in last month's tip, here are some simple exercises to help you be quicker and faster in daily life.

Put a paper cup on the kitchen table about a foot away from you. Reach out and grab it. Repeat this a little quicker. Play a game with your family and/or friends. On a count of 3, see who can grab it first. Or set a timer to ring in a specified time and then grab it when it rings.

Have someone hold a piece of paper hanging down. Put your thumb and index finger about halfway down it. Keep your fingers about one inch apart. Try to catch the paper after it has been released. Play fair.

Have someone hold 2 flashlights, one in each hand out to the side at arms' length. When that person turns on one of the flashlights, pick up your arm and point to it.

Standing in front of that person with the flashlight, have him/her point it near one foot and turn it on. Step on the light as quick as you can. Repeat this as often as you like.

Have someone stand in front of you about five feet. When that person raises his/her left hand, take a one quick step towards their hand. Step back and wait to see which hand goes up, then step towards that one. Don't get fooled.

Take it easy at first, then, build up day by day. Watch out, you just may get a little sore doing playing these games. But you will be able to move quicker and more steadily in short order.
