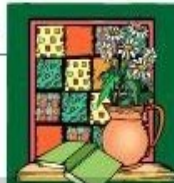

Joe Morris Spoke at the February PCACC General Meeting about the upcoming Community Mural Project

Joe Morris, a member of the parish council and youth choir director for St. Mary of the Rockies Catholic Church in Bailey, presented the plan for a community mural that will be rolled out on Bailey Day, June 15, and will continue through the summer, with completion on Aug. 25 at St. Mary's Harvest Festival.



A permanent site for the mural has not been determined, so the exact size is still up in the air. But the idea is to model the mural project roughly along the same lines as one in San Diego. For the first year, the idea is to have a mural that is roughly six feet high by 20 feet wide, for a total of 120 square feet, and sell each square foot for \$10, thus generating \$1,200. The proceeds would be split evenly between St. Mary and Conifer-based Joy International, which is devoted to the rescue of child sex slaves.

The idea is for a representative of local artists to approve ideas that people might have for the square or squares they purchase. Typically, individuals or artists purchase the squares, said Morris. Businesses can benefit by requesting that the mural be on display at their place of business, thus helping to generate foot traffic.

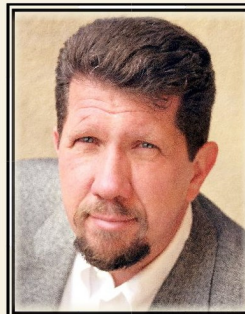
