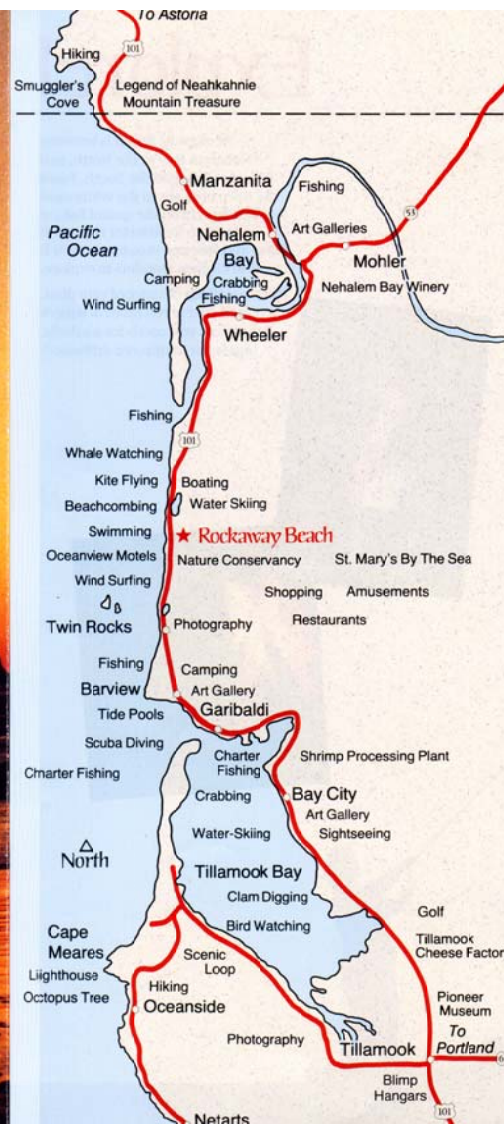

Just 88 scenic miles west of Portland on US 101, you'll find the perfect place to rediscover the art of relaxation.

Curl up with a book in your comfy Rockaway Beach hideaway overlooking the ocean, or find a driftwood chair nearer to the waves.

Other relaxing pastimes include bird watching, storm watching, whale watching, and sunbathing. Sometimes you can even catch a professional kite flyer testing the latest in kite designs.

Eating deliciously prepared, fresh seafood in our local restaurants is delightful — and equally effortless. Later on, you can watch the sun set orange between Twin Rocks and enjoy a crackling driftwood bonfire on the beach.



## Explore!

Rockaway Beach is between Nehalem Bay to the North, and Tillamook Bay to the South. From the deep blue sea to the white sand beaches, from the quaint fishing villages to freshwater rivers and lakes and forested mountains, you'll find endless wonders to explore.

Within walking distance of your door, you'll find seven miles of superb beaches as you comb for seashells, agates or sculptured driftwood.

On short day-trips you can visit art galleries, a pioneer museum, Nature Conservancy, the Tillamook Cheese Factory, the Blue Heron Cheese Factory, a shrimp processing plant or the WWII Aircraft Museum, housing memorabilia in the world's largest wooden-spanned building (which formerly berthed eight blimps). And don't miss the nearby lighthouse and Octopus tree.



## Soar!

From Bay to Bay, the more energetic visitor will discover an exciting array of activities — just let your imagination soar!

This is a playground for outdoor sport enthusiasts. You'll find places ideally suited for wind surfing, scuba diving, water-skiing, canoeing, motorboating — as well as, kite flying.

Deep sea fishing, surf and jetty fishing are also popular. We have five great rivers nearby for salmon, trout, and steelhead fishing plus several lakes with trout and bass.

How about crabbing or clamming in one of the two bays?

Tillamook County also hosts three golf courses, and miles of hiking trails, from Neah-Kah-Nie Mountain to Cascade Head on the Oregon Coast Trail.
