Lindenwood University is pleased to offer an outstanding scholarship opportunity for members of the St. Charles Chamber of Commerce.

AMOUNT: \$5,000 Scholarship plus \$2,400 in on campus work for campus residents, renewable each year for a total of \$29,600 (\$20,000 Scholarship and \$9,600 Work and Learn Award) provided the student establishes and maintains good academic status (2.0 average) and good social standing.

- CRITERIA:**
- (a) Candidate must meet University admission requirements with a minimum 20 ACT and 2.75 cumulative high school or college GPA.
 - (b) Candidate must have demonstrated academic success and leadership potential.
 - (c) Candidate must apply and remain, continuously enrolled as a full-time resident, traditional undergraduate student.
 - (d) Candidate must be a new undergraduate freshman or transfer student for the 2010-2011 academic year who has not previously attended Lindenwood, previously received a financial aid award from Lindenwood, and does not have a financial aid award from Lindenwood pending.
 - (e) Candidate must complete a financial aid application to assess eligibility for federal and/or state grants. Candidate may be eligible for additional institutional aid based on merit or need as approved by the Dean of Day Admissions. Other than the Federal Pell Grant based on need, any additional outside grants or scholarships may first replace Lindenwood University funding.
 - (f) Parents of candidate must work for a business who is a member of the St. Charles Chamber of Commerce.
 - (g) Family members of the St. Charles Chamber of Commerce Board or St. Charles Chamber of Commerce employees are eligible for the scholarships. Board members must abstain from any voting if their child is applying.
 - (h) Candidate must currently be enrolled as a student in the City of St. Charles School District, Orchard Farm School District, Francis Howell School District or Duchesne High School.

Scholarship Instructions:

- Applications will be available online through the Chamber's website – www.stcharleschamber.org
- Please include a 200-300 word essay describing: "Your personal goals and aspirations after college and how your education and talents could benefit the business environment in St. Charles County."
- Please include high school/ community college transcripts
- Please include at least 2 reference letters from non-adult family members. (One from an employer if working)
- The Scholarship Awards will be primarily based on the point system below (all requirements above must be submitted before an application can be considered). It is expected that the Scholarship committee will reach consensus on the point scoring.
 - o Precious Grades (10%) (assign points 1-10)
 - o Extra curricular activities & civic activities (50%) (assign points 1-50)
 - o Essay (40%) (assign points 1-40)
