#### Military Affairs Committee Pleased with Passage of Reciprocity Bill



Grand Forks Senator Scott Meyer carried a Bill that would help members of the military transfer a license from another state to North Dakota. A similar Bill was passed last session for spouses of military personnel in our state. This change will change Grand Forks Air Force Base from a yellow to green rating, which is critical in GFAFB mission recruitment and Base retention.

#### **Chamber Announces Chamber Non Profit Alliance**

**Purpose:** To connect and promote the non-profit community to the broader business community






