Chamber Sets Legislative Priorities

The MN and ND Legislative sessions could not be further apart in their tone and approach for business heading into 2023.

North Dakota. With a very pro-business super majority in the North Dakota legislature, a property tax relief and income tax relief will be at the top of the list for consideration. It is likely one of these will pass. Also don't expect any new onerous regulations on the business community in 2023.

Minnesota. With one party control in 2023, there will be multiple attempts to add regulations and rules on business. Expect some extreme and costly measures to be considered. The plan is to be on defense and try to keep the MN business climate as competitive as possible.

The GF/EGF Chamber will work with our local legislators in both states on business climate issues (most are supportive). We will also support the two respective State Chambers of Commerce agendas as we have in the past as a Federated member of each group

In 2006 their daughter Leah purchased the store and expanded into the fuel business with Palubicki's Express in 2012. 2016 Palubicki's Family Market and Spirits opened doubling the size of the old grocery store and adding a pharmacy, Caribou Coffee, and liquor store.

Grand Opening of UND's Nistler Hall



On September 30, Nistler College of Business & Public Administration (NCoBPA) cut the ribbon at their grand opening of Nistler Hall, welcoming the community into its newly completed campus home at the University of North Dakota (UND) in Grand Forks, ND. NCoBPA is celebrating a historic 100 years of developing leaders through transformational opportunities, impactful research, and meaningful connections. The new building is UND's vision for advancing future workforce, recruitment, and retention of students and faculty with innovation that will lead North Dakota's largest school of business into the next 100 years.

At the heart of campus, JLG Architects revived UND's signature Collegiate Gothic style within 124,000 square feet, greeting students inside a three-story open atrium with an adaptable, multi-purpose community plaza and grand fireplace. The plaza distinguishes the building's transparent wayfinding with a floating stair that connects to the second and third floor, a room-wide operable partition that opens to the auditorium, and tremendous views of the exterior plaza and campus quad.

Nistler Hall's interior is broken down into three well-connected and adaptable engagement areas, including 102 offices, with access to the latest in advanced business technology. At the touch of a button, clear glass turns opaque for privacy in large conference rooms, and all 23 classrooms will soon be equipped with high-tech cameras and audio systems, enabling "full flex" virtual learning.
