Gov. Doug Burgum told attendees at the annual Grand Forks-East Grand Forks Chamber of Commerce dinner that the community has emerged as a statewide leader in development, saying "you're doing all the right things, so keep it up."

The governor spoke discussing economic development and business activity. When he spoke of Grand Forks specifically, he seemed especially pleased with recent business developments.

"What are the four pillars of main street?" the governor asked. "One: smart, healthy communities. You guys (in Grand Forks/ East Grand Forks) are working on that – that includes a vibrant downtown. Smart infrastructure – you're working on that. Economic diversification – you're talking about that. And the other pillar is workforce.

Thank you to Kathy and all of the Ambassadors for their dedication to the Chamber and to our community.





UND Completes New State-ofthe-Art Memorial Union



University of North Dakota (UND) opened the doors and welcomed students, faculty, and community into its new Memorial Union, completed just in time for the start of fall semester. Located at the heart of UND's thriving campus, the new Memorial Union offers students and faculty an exciting experience in interactive gathering, both indoors and outdoors. Inside the glass-walled, two-story atrium is a day-lit environment with enhanced areas for dining, entertainment, ballroom events, student resources, and retail, along with state-of-the-art study and meeting spaces. The new study spaces range from individual pods to group spaces equipped with advanced Wi-Fi, HD Screens, white boards, and the latest in modern collaboration technology.

While WTW Architects in Pittsburgh, PA was the Architect of Record for the preliminary master planning, their team recruited the Grand Forksbased firm, JLG Architects to help capture UND's unique campus culture. Project studies spearheaded by WTW's Paul Knell in 2016 and 2017, kicked-off the project's planning, guided by

the UND facilities department, student affairs, and student leaders. Fifty-three percent of student voters agreed that a new facility was needed to provide student-focused space, upgraded technology and student services that would better meet the present and future needs of their student body.

Fostering campus engagement, the Memorial Union offers a multipurpose entertainment zone with a stage, open community stairs with built-in seating, and a jumbo HD screen. Students also have access to an expanded gaming lounge with TVs, table games, and a kick-back space for e-gamers. As an integral part of the master planning, WTW collaborated with JLG and local subconsultants to create an inviting outdoor dining terrace and patio space connected to the food court and adjacent to the Second Avenue pedestrian promenade. "The whole concept was centered around the Union being more than a building; it's a method for building community. We really wanted everyone to feel that sense of belonging in a modern building that still has the flavor of their traditional collegiate gothic architecture," said WTW's Amy Maceyko.
