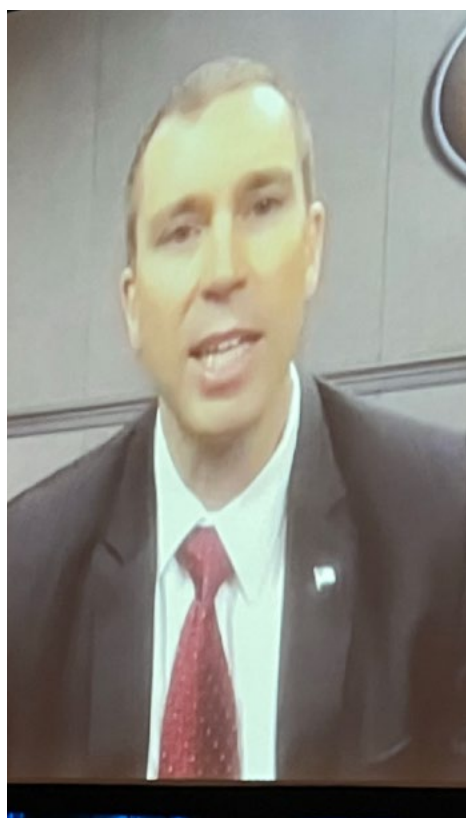

## Chamber Annual Meeting continued from page 1

The wow moment came when Tom Swoyer talked about the average salary of the 400 plus jobs at Grand Sky - \$123,000 average salary. This is a big number and the kind of jobs that benefit every chamber member business according to Russel Crary, 2023 Chamber Board Chair. More than 100 additional similar jobs will be added in 2023.

Space Development Agency's Dr. Derrick Tournear talked about the low earth orbit satellite mission that will be operation at GFAFB in 2024. George Rumford the director of Test Resource Management Center talked about the "Range Hawk" mobile test range that will be run out of Grand Sky. Northrop Grumman is converting the retiring Block 20 and 30 Global Hawks. Senators Hoeven and Cramer played a major role in securing both of these missions.

According to Chamber President, Barry Wilfahrt the Community and States investment in Grand Sky and the UAS industry is starting to really pay off. We have momentum and need to double down on our efforts. Our Legislative asks certainly do that with \$30M requested for the ND UAS Test Site and \$22M for the next tranche of infrastructure at Grand Sky in front of the ND Legislature this session.

## Chamber Summits Letters of Support on Transportation Projects

The Chamber has submitted letters along with the City of Grand Forks application to the Department of Transportation encouraging funding of two major projects:

1. The Chamber supports a new south end interchange near 47th on I-29.
  - A new interchange is projected to reduce traffic congestion considerably on 32nd Ave S
  - Improve connectivity between regional traffic visiting Grand Forks and the businesses along the I-29 corridor, 32nd Ave S, and 47th Ave S.
2. The Chamber support the City of Grand Forks effort to secure funding to reconstruct N 4th Street to match the work cone on N 3rd Street. N 3rd St from Demers Ave. to Demers Ave This project will:
  - Support redevelopment that has occurred by improving the surrounding infrastructure
  - Encourage future redevelopment with these improvements
  - Improve the feel and aesthetics of downtown Grand Forks to encourage more people to come downtown
  - Improve the safety of downtown Grand Forks

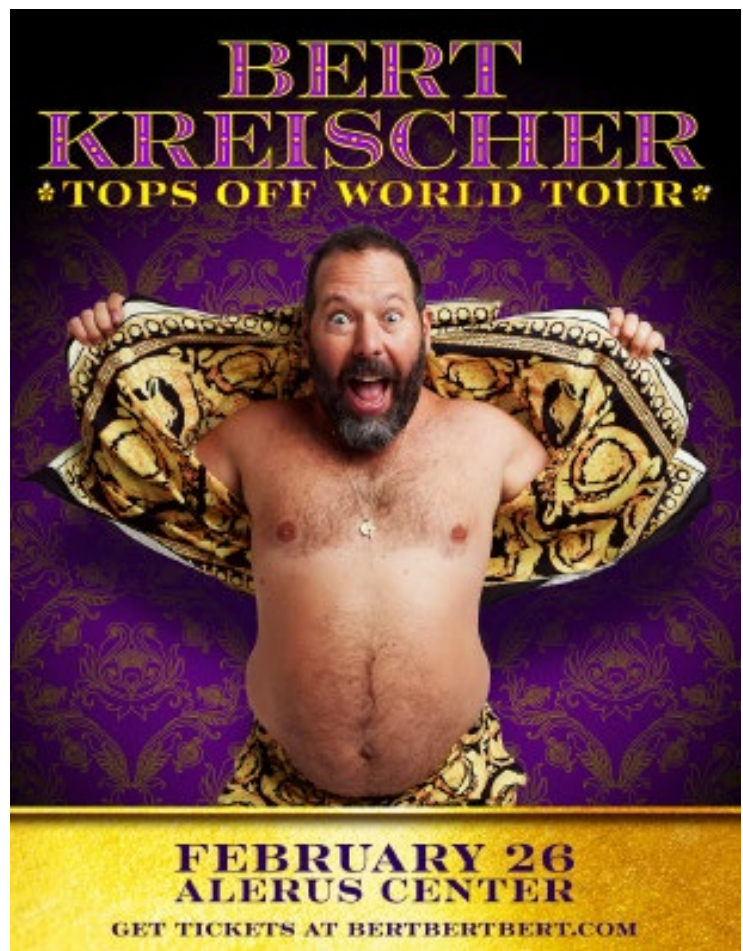

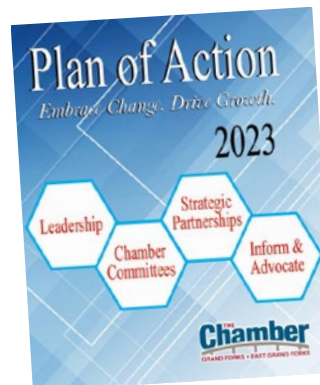
