Chamber Supports Sales Tax Extension

Grand Forks voters will go to the polls on November 14th to vote on the extension of the .75% sales tax that helps fund the Alerus Center. The tax has been on the books since 1996 and is currently set to sunset at the end of 2029. The proposed extension will continue to fund capital investments at the Alerus Center but will also fund a proposed multipurpose athletic facility South of the Alerus Center.

Recognizing the need for additional quality of life amenities and the potential revenue from additional tournaments the Chamber board strongly supports the extension of this sales tax. Chamber Board Chair Russel Crary noted when

he testified at the City Council meeting "Workforce recruitment and quality of life are closely linked. Grand Fork must continue to invest in itself to remain attractive to young talent."

Chamber Hosts Senators to talk about GFAFB Strategy

The Chamber office has been a busy place two of the past three Saturdays. Senator Hoeven and Cramer spent a couple hours with the Chamber/Mayor's Base Retention Committee members talking strategically about current missions and potential new mission recruitment for 2030 and beyond.

When things are going well it is always the time to plan for the future. While Grand Sky, TRMC, SDA and current GFAFB missions are doing well the Block 40 Global Hawks are scheduled to be retired in 2029. This gives us time to work on new missions but this effort must aggressively continue. A trip through the GFAFB museum at the entrance of the base features the many platforms that have operated out of Grand Forks. It is a testament to our community's ability to adapt and attract the latest in AF missions over the bases 70-year history. This innovation, flexibility and ability to change continues.

Chamber approves 50% funding for EGF Economic Development Planning Session

With the changing MN business climate and announced retirement of East Grand Forks EDA Director, Paul Gorte the time is perfect to do some economic development planning and prioritization for the



City of East Grand Forks. The Chamber Board helped develop a proposal and will fund half of phase one of this process. The process would identify strategic priorities and next steps.

Chamber President and CEO, Barry Wilfahrt has been at the past two EDA meeting and last month's EGF City Council meeting to talk about the need to focus on retaining businesses and on how to grow the tax base of East Grand Forks. "In light of a changing business climate in MN, identifying economic development opportunities including, workforce recruitment, housing and quality of life initiatives will be important to the future growth of EGF. Also educating East Grand Forks businesses on the programs they qualify for under the MN Department of Economic Development will be a key piece to business retention.

At the end of the day it is a different environment in Minnesota. It presents different challenges and opportunities and we need to be prepared to think differently and capitalize on those opportunities. This planning process sets that in motion.


