What is the proposal we will be voting on?



It is a half-cent sales tax dedicated to street improvement and the new water treatment plant.

\$5M

The sales tax will raise about \$5 million per year.



60% of the money will go to streets and 40% to paying off the water treatment plant.



The sales tax will sunset in 20 years.

Why use a sales tax?



Using a sales tax takes pressure off local special assessments, property taxes and water rates.



A sales tax accelerates the city's ability to fund needed street improvements and improves public safety and our quality of life in Grand Forks.



And people who live outside of Grand Forks, but come to our city for jobs and amenities will also help pay for our basic city infrastructure.



Lower utility rates will help keep Grand Forks competitive in attracting and retaining jobs and industry.
