



**Hahira's Annual "Antiques & Uniques" Car Show
presented in honor of the fallen and families affected by events
on September 11th, 2001.**

The City of Hahira announces its annual car show "Motorin' On Main" and 9/11 Tribute will take place on Saturday, Sept. 11th, 2010, in Downtown Hahira. Festivities include displays by local enthusiasts and car clubs (10am til 2pm) followed by a parade through the Downtown (at 2pm), with live entertainment provided throughout the day by "Grafted by Grace."

At noon, a special 9/11 remembrance ceremony will be held at the Red Caboose on Main Street, including the national anthem, tribute song, and special guest speaker from Moody Air Force Base.

Car show participants will compete to win prizes in categories such as "Oldest Model," "Highest Odometer Reading," and "Driven Farthest," along with the title of "Best in Show." In addition to being awarded prizes, car show winners will ride at the front of the parade through the Downtown area.

The show is open to all forms of transportation, including classic autos, newer models, motorcycles, and anything rare or unique. Registration is \$10 prior to the event or \$15 the day of (event day registration begins at 9:45am at the Red Caboose on Main Street).
