

The Italian Riviera, also known as the "Riviera Ligure", is a narrow coastal strip that lies between the Ligurian Sea and the Alps. Enjoy "picture perfect" fishing villages, such as Portofino, Santa Margherita de Ligure, and the historic seaport of Genoa. The French Riviera, or Côte d'Azur, is a sun-soaked stretch of coastline that skirts the Mediterranean in the southeast corner of France. The French cities live and breathe *la belle époque* and centuries-old villages crown the peaks of the rugged landscape whose inhabitants tend the olive trees and grape vines that traverse the countryside. From museums to castles and storied resorts, the beauty of both nature and culture in the French Riviera abounds at every corner. Traveling to the glamorous French Riviera is a feast for all the senses.

**Pricing:** Tour price is \$2,995 per person, double occupancy. For single occupancy, add \$495. Fuel surcharges are included at \$475 per person and air taxes are included at \$139 per person. Fuel surcharges and air taxes are valid at the time of printing but are subject to change. Optional Italian Lakes is \$695 per person double occupancy. For single occupancy add \$295. ## ITINERARY

**Day 1 – US:** Depart the U. S. for Italy.

**Day 2 – Santa Margherita Ligure:** Upon arrival, proceed to baggage claim and after clearing customs you will be met by your tour escort. Transfer to your hotel in Santa Margherita Ligure. After check in enjoy an orientation tour with your tour manager. Set on the Gulf of Tigullio between Rapallo and Portofino, the resort/fishing town of Santa Margherita Ligure really couldn't be in a better neighbourhood. Fashionable but much quieter than Portofino, life in Santa Margherita Ligure centres around the lovely palm-laden harbour, where boating and simple sunning are the orders of the day. The town has some good shopping options, lovely cafes and interesting sights like its 16th-century castle and the 17th-century Basilica di Santa Margherita. Welcome dinner at the Hotel (Dinner)

**Day 3: Santa Margherita/ Portofino/ Genoa:** This morning we are off to world famous Portofino. A playground for the rich, famous, and fabulously chic since the late 19th century, the former fishing village remains one of the most exclusive locations on the Ligurian coast. Behind all that glitz, however, you can still uncover the area's local traditions in the nearby villages. Follow the pathway up the Salita di San Giorgio, past the yellow Church of San Giorgio, to the 16th-century castle, named after a British consul in Genoa, Montague Yeats Brown. This is the best place to take spectacular photographs of the town. You will have free time for lunch on your own in one of the outdoor patios overlooking Portofino's bay. In the afternoon travel to Genoa, Italy's principal seaport. Genoa, *Genova* in Italian, was the site of EXPO 92 and a 2004 European Culture Capital made famous by Columbus. We will walk to the historic center said to be the largest medieval quarter in Europe, with a wealth of churches, palaces, and museums. In 2006, Genoa's *Rolli* Palaces were added to the list of UNESCO World Heritage Sites. And for our food lovers, we will have an opportunity to try the traditional Geona salami and sample "Pesto" which comes from this region. (Breakfast, Dinner)

**Day 4 – Santa Margherita Ligure/ OPTIONAL TOUR Piedmont:** Today is to enjoy at your at your leisure. Maybe discover Cinque Terra on your own **OR** take an optional tour to discover the Piedmont region, one of the most famous wine regions in the world and a "must do" for true wine lovers and collectors. Our tour leads us into the heart of the Monferrato wine area. We will drive through spectacular hills colored with golden vineyards. Our first stop is the historic Canelli, historical center of the production of Moscato and spumante wines. Canelli is famous for its vast underground network of wine cellars dating back centuries and still in use today. You'll see one of the most beautiful historic wine cellars and enjoy a tasting. Next proceed to visit the medieval town of Asti a small city with an old city centre with narrow winding streets; discover its noble palaces, medieval towers churches and cloisters. Lunch in Included. We will also visit a Barbera winery to learn the secret of this prestigious dark wine which is aged in barrels, today among the most popular Piedmont wines. Return to Santa Margherita, evening at leisure. (Breakfast). \*\*\*\***Optional tour price: 125USD per person**

**Day 5 – Santa Margherita / San Remo/ Montecarlo / Cannes:** After breakfast we will depart to France. We will stop along the way and visit San Remo the luxurious capital of the Italian Riviera, where flowers bloom throughout the year. Alfred Nobel conceived of his prizes while residing in this city's inspirational surroundings, which has long attracted aristocrats and the wealthy. We'll then leave Italy and cross the border into Monaco, where your visit, to the Old Town of Monte Carlo, includes free time to see on your own the palace, the changing of the guard, the Cathedral and the Jacques Cousteau Oceanographic Museum. Continue your tour of Monte Carlo with a lap on the famous roads used for the Formula One Grand Prix. You will then have free time at Casino Square to do some luxury shopping, see the stunning gardens and mega-yachts in the harbour or simply sip a coffee at the Hotel des Paris or the Hermitage and the watch beautiful people go by. Arrival in Cannes in the afternoon. Dinner this evening is on own. (Breakfast)

**Day 6 – Cannes/Nice:** Today, after a relaxing breakfast, we visit Nice. Enjoy a guided tour of the city and Immerse yourself in Nice's history on Place Garibaldi in the Old Town and marvel at the modern New Town as you stroll along Promenade des Anglais, which dates back almost 200 years and lines the city's Mediterranean coast at the Baie des Anges (Bay of Angels) Enjoy the afternoon at leisure and stroll by an elegant café, visit the flower market and admire the baroque buildings along Promenade des Anglais.. If art inspires you then you may visit the Matisse Museum, the Museum of Contemporary pop art, Chagall's museum featuring the artist's biblical inspired masterpieces, or Beaux-Arts Museum housing 4 centuries of fine European art, from Monet to Rodin to Picasso. (Breakfast)

**Day 7 - Cannes / Provence Countryside and Wine Tasting/Lunch:** After breakfast enjoy the scenic drive to Provence, where you will visit Gourdon and Saint Paul de Vence. Drive through Provence's picture-postcard countryside to the second-most visited village in France, Saint Paul de Vence with its cobblestone streets and chic art galleries, it's easy to see why the town is so popular. You'll have free time to explore this former haunt of the Impressionist painters. Your day trip continues to Tourrettes/Loup for a photo stop before visiting the charming Loup Gorges. The views of the Alps, valleys and Mediterranean coastline from the perched medieval village of Gourdon are stunning. During the course of the day there will be a visit to a local winery with a tasting and lunch and also sample the traditional floral-scented candy at the Florian confectionery, a French Riviera specialty. (Breakfast, Lunch)

**Day 8 – Cannes / Antibes / Juan les Pins / Cannes:** After breakfast depart for a day tour discovering the magnificent French Riviera. Our first stop is Antibes, here you will have free time to discover the Old Town and Picasso Museum. Don't forget to check out Billionaire's Quay, overlooked by the 15th century Fort Vauban, and home to multi-million dollar yachts. Pass the celebrities villas of Cap D'Antibes, continue along the scenic coastline to Golfe-Juan where Napoleon landed in 1815, and Juan-les-Pins, passing by the famous seafront and Pine Grove with trendy boutiques. We will return to Cannes for some at leisure and our Farewell dinner tonight. (Breakfast, Dinner)

**Day 9 – Nice / US:** Transfer to the Nice airport. Depart for your flight home.

### Three nights **OPTIONAL EXTENSION** to the Lakes of Northern Italy & Milan: **695USD per person**

**Day 9 Nice / Lake Maggiore:** After breakfast depart to Lake Maggiore. Upon arrival enjoy a cruise to the Borromean Islands. You will stop at Isola Bella and visit the 17th century Borromean Palace with its splendid paintings and its botanical gardens filled with exotic plants. Later reach your hotel in Baveno or Stresa, Rest of the afternoon at leisure. Dinner at the Hotel (Breakfast, Dinner)

**Day 10 - Lake Como:** Breakfast at the hotel. Departure with your tour leader to discover Lake Como a jewel-like oasis of tranquility and a magical combination of lush Mediterranean Foliage & snowy alpine peaks. Its captivating landscape and villa gardens inspired many 19th century Romantic poets and artists, and continues to draw visitors from around the world. After your cruise on the lake visit the charming Bellagio. On the southern shore, Bellagio, also called by locals "la perla del lago" (the pearl of the lake), is considered the most beautiful town in Europe. Stroll through its narrow cobbled streets and enjoy the breathtaking views of the impeccable homes and glorious villas that surround the lake. Enjoy the evening at leisure. (Breakfast)

**Day 11 At Leisure - OPTIONAL TOUR TO MILAN :** Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy the day at leisure or join us on an optional tour to discover Milan. Visit the Convent of Santa Maria delle Grazie to take in Leonardo da Vinci's mural The Last Supper (pending reservation), which he painted on the refectory wall at the request of his patron, Ludovico Sforza, Duke of Milan. You will also admire the magnificent Castello Sforzesco with its many museums and in particular a collection of musical instruments. Continue for a walking tour to admire the Duomo the great Cathedral of Milan, a striking example of Gothic architecture. The nearby La Scala opera house and the impressive Galleria Vittorio Emanuele, the world's first Mall, and other landmark points of interest. Afternoon at disposal to discovery Milan city center and the best fashion stores of all Italy, if not the world. Farewell dinner is at the hotel. (Breakfast, Dinner). **Optional Tour Price: 95USD per person.**

**Day 12 – Lake Maggiore / US:** Transfer to the Milan airport. Depart for your flight home.

**Air arrangements:** Fares and schedules are based on regular scheduled carrier service. All applicable airline rules apply and schedules are subject to change. Basic airfares include fuel surcharges, airport departure taxes, passenger facility charges (PFCs), customs or immigration fees, but do not include excess baggage charges and any other airline imposed charges. For mileage accrual information, please contact the carrier directly for details. Air inclusive group packages are non-changeable and non-refundable once deposit has been paid. Rules and fees for canceling and revising airfares vary depending upon the type of airfare purchased. Refundable airline tickets will be processed once the original paper tickets (if applicable) are returned to us via a traceable method of mailing. E-tickets do not need to be returned. Lost paper tickets have no refund value.

**IMPORTANT NOTE ON FUEL SURCHARGES:** Fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines are valid at time of contract and are included in the price of your tour. As fuel continues to fluctuate, if the fuel surcharges change prior to your departure date, you will be assessed this additional amount.

**Cancellation Policies:** No charges other than the non-refundable initial deposit are levied for individual passengers canceling up to 120 days prior to the commencement of Jet Vacations LLC services. However, services which have been prepaid by Jet Vacations LLC on behalf of individual clients maybe non-refundable, non-exchangeable, non changeable and/or maybe subject to a cancellation- change fee (e.g. theater tickets, Train tickets, Airline Tickets, Event Tickets, Passes, Entrance fees etc.).

**Full cancellation:** Failing to pay the contractual deposits (other than the initial deposit) constitutes a cancellation. In the event of non-compliance with the payment due dates, Jet Vacations LLC shall have the right to demand the Customer to immediately pay the outstanding balance. Payment shall then be received by Jet Vacations LLC within eight days as of the date of Jet Vacations LLC's written request. Should payment not be received within this time limit, the group stay shall be deemed to be canceled by the Customer. In the event of full cancellation of the agreement by the Customer, which is not justified by Jet Vacations LLC's failure to meet its obligations, cancellation penalties shall be invoiced and calculated as follows:

- Initial deposit\*\*: non-refundable.
- From 119 to 91 days prior to departure: 30% penalty of the total cost per person.
- From 90 to 61 days prior to departure: 50% penalty of the total cost per person.
- From 60 to 31 days prior to departure: 75% penalty of the total cost per person.
- From 30 to day of departure & no show: 100% penalty of the total cost per person.

\*\* Initial deposit is non-refundable. A passenger becoming a single as a result of a partner's cancellation must pay the single supplement.

**NOTE:** The following non-refundable fees will be added to the penalty charges listed on the cancellation (full or partial) schedule above: Travel protection premiums. Airline tickets - airline penalties, which may be up to 100% of the ticket

value. Refundable airline tickets will be processed once the original paper tickets (if applicable) are returned to us via a traceable method of mailing. E-tickets do not need to be returned. Lost paper tickets have no refund value.

**Travel protection plan:** The Travel Protection Plan may not be purchased after final payment has been made. Insurance cost for travel packages priced between \$2,501 and \$3,000 is US\$205 per person; from \$3,001 to \$4,000: \$272 per person; from \$4,001 to \$5,000: \$342 per person; from \$5,001 to \$6,000: \$408 per person and from \$6,001 to \$7,000: \$475 per person. Insurance premium has to be purchased within 5 days of booking. You understand that the travel insurance is provided by a third party and that all claims will have to be addressed directly with the Travel Insurance Provider.

**Itinerary variation:** We will make every effort to operate all tours as advertised. Situations may arise, voluntarily or involuntarily, that require changes or exceptions in the airport of departure, the itinerary, land arrangements, hotels, trains or ports of call. On these occasions, we reserve the right to make such modifications and substitute conveyances/hotels as deemed necessary.

**Minimum participants to Operate:** Group needs a minimum of 20 participants to operate. Optional tours need a minimum of 15 participants to operate.

**Tour Cancellation:** We reserve the right to cancel the entire trip (or any component of the trip) for any reason and/or time. In this event, our liability, if any, shall be limited to and liquidated by refunding to each prospective participant the payments made.
