Once their four class punches are up, they will need to join the CRC or pay a day pass and class fee to continue participating in classes. If you have friends, neighbors or strangers that need a gentle hand-holding to get them hooked on fitness, please let them know about this great opportunity.*

*DXF (Dance/Fitness workout from 5:30 – 6:30 on Wednesday Nights.) This is a new class that is growing in popularity, but not to worry there is space for you.*

*Deep Water Cardio Fitness Class is starting Tuesday, October 22. It takes place on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5 to 6 pm.*

*Adult Swim Lessons are also going to start back up on October 26. We need five participants to run the class so we have a pre-registration requirement of October 23. This is for adults who are interested in improving their swimming skills.
