It includes evening lectures on Friday and local day field trips on Saturday and Sunday. Classroom presentations will take place in Port Angeles. The intent is to learn about the Elwha River and explore the ancient connections between Southern Resident Orcas, Chinook salmon, and their mutual interdependence on intact ecosystems. This workshop is ideal for those wishing to continue their education as a naturalist or for those who simply have an interest in learning about these topics.
