From transportation and land use to housing, workforce access, and infrastructure investment, STLCO 2050 serves as a framework for thoughtful, coordinated growth across St. Louis County. A defining feature of STLCO 2050 is its foundation in community input. Shaped by resident feedback, the plan reflects the priorities of those who live and work throughout the county. Joel will share how this collective vision was developed and how public engagement helped inform strategies that guide future growth and investment.*
