There are wide open spaces, clean country air, friendly people and lots of great food. There is plenty to explore, experience and eat. Amishland and Lakes is famous for great SAG food (watermelons, grapes, plum, blueberries, bananas, cookies and more), and there are also Amish bakeries, restaurants and homemade ice cream parlors along the route.
