Everyone should have their

EIN – if you do not have an EIN you can get it from the IRS website, takes about 15 minutes -- <https://www.irs.gov/businesses/small-businesses-self-employed/apply-for-an-employer-identification-number-ein-online>

*Birth Certificate or Passport or Permanent Resident Card or Certificate of Naturalization
Valid Driver's License*

The other documents are based on their specific situation.
