Seneca Healthcare District (SHD) is continuing to coordinate administering vaccinations to our community following guidelines for Phase 1b Tier 1 age 75 years and over. On Wednesday, February 17 a successful vaccination clinic took place where 64 individuals received second doses of their COVID-19 vaccination.

As SHD works with Plumas County Public Health Agency (PCPHA) to vaccinate the greater population, we appreciate the continued support from all the basins fire agencies and the community.

SHD staff members are receiving questions on how to sign up for the COVID-19 vaccination. All vaccinations are booked through the Plumas County Public Health Agency.

This is the county's information portal that will allow PCPHA to notify individuals when the vaccine is available for the **phase and tier in which they are categorized**.

According to PCPHA's "Plumas County is currently vaccinating Phase 1b Tier 1. The state has prioritized 65 and older regardless of underlying medical condition for Phase 1b Tier 1. Plumas County is currently vaccinating 75 and older and will start vaccinating those 65 -74 years old the week of February 22, 2021, with 70% of vaccines being allocated to the 65 and older age group and 30% of vaccines to the sectors in Phase 1b Tier 1, as mandated by the state."
