### **PARTNERSHIPS**

Economic Development for the City of Estherville and Emmet County is managed by the **Estherville Area Growth Partnership**. This non-profit organization is funded through the City of Estherville, Emmet County, and private business partnerships.

Because of the shared goals and missions of both organizations the Estherville Area Growth Partnership is now housed alongside the Estherville Area Chamber of Commerce. They share one Director but continue to have two individual Board or Directors. These two organizations work hand in hand for the betterment of Estherville and it's surrounding area.

The Partnership's main focus is on business retention, expansion and creation. An important focus of this organization is making sure that our existing businesses have the necessary resources to remain and thrive in our community. Both the Estherville Chamber and the partnership are there to help Estherville businesses whether they are brand new startups, new to the community, or already established!

### **AMBASSADORS**

The **Estherville Chamber Ambassadors** are the charitable arm of the Chamber. They host ribbon cuttings and celebrations for new businesses and major business changes. The Estherville Chamber is an asset to our community. They offer a wide variety of services and assistance to existing and potential businesses within the Estherville community. They do a great job organizing and facilitating community events like the Flight Breakfast, Sweet Corn Days and the Fright Hike to name just a few."



**Excel! Estherville** is a non-profit organization that leads community development. The Estherville Community voted in a 1% local option sales tax and Excel advises the Estherville City Council on how the funds should be spent.

The Board is made up of City Officials and Community Members. This organization focuses on quality of life and place projects. Large projects such as the new swimming pool, parks, walking paths, community art and much more are largely funded through this organization. Many community and business grants including the Façade Grant, Interior Remodel, Second Story window Grant and Neighborhood Façade Grant are funded by Excel. The Estherville Chamber Director has an at large seat on the Excel Board, and facilitates grant paperwork and many of the daily operations.

### TOURISM AND MARKETING

The Estherville Chamber is the designated Tourism and Marketing entity for Estherville and Emmet County. We advertise our area in several large scale publications including the lowa Travel Guide and magazines. Each year we work with the Estherville News to create and distribute the Estherville Community Guide to both visitors and community members. We use social media which includes inviting bloggers to our area and having a well established Facebook and Instagram page. We also created the Estherville Chamber Member Business and Community Updates Facebook Group that allows our members to post business updates, specials and more to thousands of community members at no cost.

A fun marketing tool we have had great success with is Estherville and event themed clothing and merchandise. We enjoy creating ways for our community members and visitors to show their love and pride for Estherville and Sweet Corn Days. Estherville is a special place, and we are fortunate to get to use our marketing skills to tell everyone just how unique it is!

### Savings

The chamber creates advertising materials (in moderation) on behalf of our members. We offer the opportunity for member businesses to receive discounts for events and publications such as the Community Guide or Farm, Home and Living Show. We save you time and money actively referring and advertising on your behalf.

### **Marketing**

We promote our businesses and Estherville to our residents and outside our community. We drive tourism into our town. We advertise Estherville on a State and National level to make us stand out!

All members start at the base fee of \$225 (unless noted differently in a category on the next page). Base membership fee includes an owner or manager, who is not counted as an employee.

#### **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

Each business in this category pays the base fee plus \$32 for each of the first ten employees. They pay \$5 for each employee beyond ten. The owner/manager is counted in the base fee and not in the employee total. Add the base fee plus the appropriate amount for employees to get your total investment. (2 part time employees = 1 full time)

#### **FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS:**

Base rate: \$525 plus \$32 per employee plus \$20 per million in deposits

#### **MOTELS:**

The base rate includes the first ten rooms. Add the base fee plus \$11 for each room over ten to determine your total investment. There is no per employee investment.

### NON-PROFITS AND EDUCATION:

The base rate is \$275 plus \$1.50 for each employee.

### **HOME BUSINESS:**

The base rate is \$100 plus \$32 for each employee.

### MULTIPLE BUSINESSES OWNED BY THE SAME FAMILY

The base rate + \$32 for each employee for all businesses owned by the same household.

#### **UTILITIES/GOVERNMENT**

Varies by utility and governmental entity. Call chamber office for details.

### OUT OF COUNTY HOME BASED BUSINESS

\$100 flat rate

### OUT OF COUNTY GENERAL BUSINESSES

\$250 flat rate.

### **CHAMBER CHAMPIONS:**

The investment rate is \$65 (This category includes civic and service groups, churches, individuals, and other non-business groups.)
