



Marshall Autumn Fest Prince/Princess 2021

Greetings!

The Marshall Autumn Fest is quickly approaching and that means it's time to find our Prince and Princess candidate for 2021!

The Prince/Princess program is a fundraiser for the Marshall Autumn Fest that helps bring in money to put on the completely free weekend of family fun and entertainment September 17-19, 2021 around the Courthouse Square!

Each year, we have 6 boys and 6 girls who each raise money to earn their way to become the Marshall Autumn Fest Prince and Princess.

Requirements:

- Children must be ages 5-6 at the time of the festival.
- They must live in Marshall School District
- They must not have participated in the contest previously.

How it works:

We, the committee, set out canisters in businesses throughout the town with the participants picture on them. Patrons of the business, family and friends of the participants, and the public are encouraged to put spare change in the cans of the participants they are supporting. Quite simply, the boy and girl with the most money at the end of the contest wins Prince & Princess. We will also be hosting a "Meet the Royalty" night at a local business where we ask each candidate to attend, if able, to help raise money for the festival. The date and location of this night will be determined closer to the event and you will be made aware so that your child can attend if able. The opening ceremony of the Marshall Autumn Fest on Friday September 17th at 6:00 p.m. will be the announcement and crowning of this year's Prince & Princess. All participants will ride in the parade on Saturday morning in vehicles provided by the Autumn Fest Committee. The first 6 boys and the first 6 girls who sign up will be the candidates from the 2021 Prince & Princess contest, so don't wait to get your child signed up!
