The Affton Christian Food Pantry is adding positions to our volunteer corps to better meet the needs of our clients. We have numerous positions that we would like to fill in order to operate more efficiently.

The positions and times listed below are the ONLY positions we have open at this time. Individuals can sign up for as many open positions/times as they like...for example...once a month, twice a month or every week (if that position exists, i.e. interviewer on Saturdays)

Substitutes *	(see note below)		

Note: **Substitutes** are called upon from time to time to fill a need for a regular volunteer on a one time or short-term basis. The request for a substitute could come from a volunteer any time the pantry is open. Individuals who wish to be a substitute would have to work a regular shift for several times in order to be trained. Substitutes are generally not called to volunteer at the Food Pantry without any training. The only except would be for the processing teams on Monday or Thursday mornings. Those shifts are currently at capacity for both regular volunteers and substitutes.

**Open to serve Clients:**

Monday	12:30pm – 2:30pm
Tuesday	4pm – 6pm
Thursday	6pm – 8pm
Saturday	9am – 11:30am

Volunteers for these shifts are expected to show up ½ hour ahead of the time listed for set up and to stay ½ hour at the end of the shift for cleanup.

**Open to handle food Processing/Stocking**

Monday	8:30am – 11:30am
Tuesday	9:30am – 11am
Thursday	8:30am – 11:30am
Friday	9:30am – 11am

Volunteers for these shifts should expect that their shift could be longer or shorter depending on the number of items donated and the specific needs of the pantry on those days.
