We have different positions open:

Junior Leadership Staff- Juniors-1 year removed from High School. This is a 2-week unpaid internship. Youth will get the opportunity to learn what a real job interview is like, they will get to put this internship on college applications and other job applications, they can use us as a reference, and they will get the opportunity to try all the different positions of at camp (counselor, wrangler, kitchen, maintenance, etc.), and they will get time to grow in their faith. On weekends, they will go home.

Counselors- Care for resident campers, facilitate various activities including worship, bible studies, archery, ropes course, fishing, camping, and more, maintain the safety of all participants, work together as a team, communicate with supervisory staff, and other duties as assigned. This position lives in the cabins with the campers, including overnight, Monday-Friday, and some weekends. Breaks will be given each day. Must be 18+. One year removed from high school preferred.

Wranglers-Work directly under the Head Wrangler in managing the herd of horses and livestock. Maintain safety at the barn and on trial rides, maintain barn, pasture, and trail cleanliness and function, and all duties as assigned. Must be 18+

Cook- Cook for a group of up to 150, works closely with other kitchen staff, assists in menu planning, manages special diets, communicates with Site Improvement staff, maintains meal count records, unload deliveries, and other duties as assigned. Hours negotiable (or until everything is done)

Maintenance- work with the Site Improvement Coordinator to maintain the function, safety, and cleanliness of the camp. Includes various jobs, including cleaning, plumbing, electrical, fence work, automotive, and more.

Nurse/ Health Aide- Manage and record all camper medications, communicate with parents, perform 1st aid when needed, communicate medical and dietary needs with counselors and kitchen staff, and other duties as needed.
