




Starting in 2021, Golden Triangle RC&D is providing a limited number of free water quality tests to low income households in Southwest Georgia.

Approved household water wells will be tested for bacteria, metals and minerals. Results of the testing are mailed to the well owner along with an explanation of the results. All results will be kept confidential.
