- 1. Theme for 2024 is: "Ewe're Out of This World"
- 2. Any person or group may enter the Lamb Derby Parade.
- 3. Drivers must possess a valid driver's license.
- 4. Units with sound or unusual noises must be indicated on the entry form.
- 5. PLEASE! No alcohol consumption on the parade route.
- 6. You are asked to Check-in, and Pick up your line-up number between 7:00 and 9:30 a.m. in the Lobby of City Hall (201 North Lassen St.). Only one member of each group is necessary to check-in and pick up the placement entry number. Parade officials will be available to direct you to your place in the line-up.
- 7. Parade begins at 10:00 a.m. SHARP. You must check in no later than 9:30 a.m.
- 8. Entry numbers are to be placed on the passenger side toward the front of your unit. You <u>must</u> have a lamb icon on the passenger side (right) of your unit.
- 9. Keep in *forward motion* at all times.
- 10. Keep at least two car lengths between units. Please follow instructions given to you by the parade officials.
- 11. All units must complete the parade route.
- 12. Throwing objects from your unit on the parade is forbidden. You may have people walk beside your unit and hand out candy or trinkets. Throwing objects will potentially disqualify your entry from the prize categories.
- 13. Entries must have FULL control of animals or vehicles at all times.
- 14. Marching and Drill Team Units are asked not to stop and perform in front of the Judges. There will be **NO NOISE** within the <u>SILENT</u> area. The Judging Stand is at Memorial Hall (Lassen to Murdock).
- 15. Awards will be announced and given out at the Large Gazebo in Jensen Park at 1:00 p.m.
- 16. The Parade Committee reserves the right to reject any entry not considered safe.

PARADE ROUTE:

Parade length is 1 mile

Begin on Butte Street parallel to Northern Valley Indian Health.

Proceed South on Butte Street to Sycamore Street.

Turn West onto Sycamore Street, and proceed to Crawford Street.

Turn North onto Crawford Street, and proceed to Willow Street.

Turn East onto Willow Street, and proceed to the Willows High School Parking Lot on Merrill Street.

The parade is over, and we hope you had fun!!!

You may now proceed to Jensen Park for the rest of the festivities.
